This is an established role within the Company, working closely with the Hire team involved with the distribution of portable toilets, cabins, utility vehicles, and other portable accommodation to commercial sites and events (local and large national events) throughout the country.

Objective

To work within the team as a key member, responsible for delivery and collection of portable units as detailed above using a HGV crane vehicle mainly in the North of England but may be required to work throughout the country.

Responsible to

Hire Supervisor at our Leeds Depot, but will be accountable for their own tasks on a daily basis.

Duties

- Load, deliver, and site units as described above
- Point of contact with client on event site
- Liaise with client with regard to actual location of units
- Upon end of event re-visit location to load unit/s and return to depot or move to another location.
- Communication with the Hire Supervisor and other site staff regarding progress of works.
- Co-ordinate workload with deliveries from other transport companies

Person Specification

Essential Skills

- Good driving skills and knowledge of UK driving legislation
- UK C+E (Class 1) Driving Licence or European equivalent
- Crane wagon experience - Must be licensed to use HIAB
- Must be able to work within strict time-frames
- Good communication skills with ability to discuss issues with Hire Supervisor, and other site and company personnel.

- Ability to work as part of a team
- Availability for period/s away from base

Desirable Skills

- Previous knowledge of delivering to the construction or events industries

Other Information:

All full-time drivers will have a driver assessment in line with our policies and procedures prior to commencing work and will need to have current licences.

Holidays: 22 per annum plus statutory holidays

Please note that this role is temporary for the period March to September but may become permanent depending upon skill set and workload within the depot.

The role is split between two elements -

- Work out of Leeds depot, delivering cabins and other assets to clients in the Yorkshire region. Occasional late finishes / early starts and some weekend work for local events.
- Working for our Events Division out of our Leeds depot, delivering cabins and other assets to clients at events nation-wide. Some weekend and overnights but basic hours are Monday to Friday.

Hourly week is 42.5 hours. Any authorised overtime will be paid at the rate as documented in our Company Staff Handbook
